Consumer Rebates

Each year TECT distributes the majority of its funds direct to consumers*. The calculation sees eligible consumers receiving a fixed amount, plus a variable amount based on their total spend over the qualifying period**. TECT will distribute \$30 million directly to consumers this year with a fixed (minimum) amount of \$440 (2018 was \$435).

Confirmed Changes:

- 1. Direct payments Rebates will be paid direct into eligible consumers'** bank accounts. If preferred, consumers can have their rebate credited to their Trustpower power account. This will be the default payment method if no bank account details are provided.
- 2. No fixed amount for gas or internet There will no longer be a fixed amount for gas or internet services. Each consumer will receive a fixed amount for electricity only, and a variable amount based on their total spend with Trustpower for all services over the qualifying period.
